## Staff Spotlight: Miss Steph

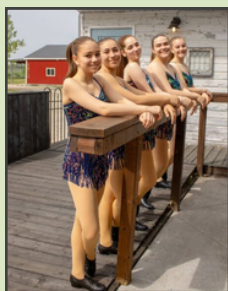
### Teaching: Hip Hop & Lyrical
